Understanding the Importance of Sharing the Gospel

THINK ABOUT IT...

How did you come to know Jesus? Did someone share the Gospel with you? Your answer must be yes. So before going further into this lesson stop for a moment and think about that. Someone, a follower of Jesus, took the time to share the greatest news that you've ever heard. Doesn't that make you feel valuable? Doesn't that make you feel like someone really loves you? He has saved you to share the Gospel for the name of His Son Jesus. Remember that if He desires you to share His good news, He will equip you as you study His Word and fill you with His Spirit. (Acts 1:8) Think of one more thing before you read on... If someone had not shared the Gospel with you, from a sermon or individually, would you be walking in your new life of joy today?

HOW DO I SHARE THE GOSPEL?

Fear is one of the greatest tools of the enemy against you when it comes to sharing your faith with others. He, as well as yourself, will make you afraid. You will think you are unlearned and that you need to be more advanced in your new life before you can share your faith with others. Now is when you need to share your faith. The Bible teaches us about a man who was blind since his birth. It tells us that Jesus came by and healed him. As soon as the man could see, imagine the glory he gave unto God through what Jesus had done. Later Jesus came to him again and asked him if he would believe on the Son of God. The man answered, "Lord, I believe." Then the Bible says this man worshipped Jesus. With neighbors, friends and any person... this man shared what Jesus had done. Maybe some would tempt him to calm down or wait until he could be sure of his new sight. "You've just met Jesus; how can you be so sure of Him?" some could have said. This man who was blind his whole life is now testifying of all things he sees and believes. Just like you! Don't wait on sharing your faith when you become educated or experienced. You share what Jesus has done in you and that He is God's Son who is worthy of our worship. Share your new sight now because you have truly been born-again. (John 9:25; John 9:31-33; John 9:35-38)
